## Why Partner with Faith First Georgia?

### For Schools

- Faith First Georgia only partners with private Christian schools that maintain a Christ-centered focus for the education of the next generation of Georgians.
- Faith First Georgia updates all partner schools with donation and scholarship information summaries twice per month. Schools are up to date with the amount of donations available for awards and the awards distributed to the school year to date.
- Faith First Georgia relies on our partner schools to determine the criteria for scholarship awards best suited for the needs of the students, school and community supporting the school. Faith First Georgia does not impose any arbitrary requirements for scholarship qualifications other than the eligibility requirement listed in HB 1133/325.
- Faith First Georgia distributes scholarship award checks to the schools usually within five business days of receiving a scholarship request from the school.
- Faith First Georgia awards the total amount of scholarship approved by the school according to the available funds, instead of "obligating" the award for distribution at some later date.
- Faith First Georgia offers seminars about the program for parents, donors and schools at no cost to the school.
- Faith First Georgia is available to our partner schools by phone or email.

### For Donors

- Faith First Georgia allows donors to direct their donations to the partner schools of their choice.
- Faith First Georgia is readily available by phone or email for answering questions about the donation process.
- Faith First Georgia's process quickly turns a donation into a scholarship award in as little as five business days.

### For Parents/Students

- Faith First Georgia quickly distributes checks for approved scholarship awards to the school (within five business days).
- Faith First Georgia holds training sessions to educate and inform parents about eligibility requirements for a student to participate in the program and receive a scholarship. Faith First Georgia provides this service at no charge.
